**Achievements of Degree College Students for various events are as follows :**

## • **BADMINTON**

Our College badminton team comprising of Pravin Upadhyya, Rohit More, Pavan Singh and Ameya Joshi, Won the Championship at the Mumbai University Level.

Our star badminton player Rohit More was selected for National Doubles. He is the Semi Finalist at the National Level. He also represented Thane district at interstate Senior Championship and won the team Championship.

Amey Joshi has been selected to represent Maharashtra in West Zone Interstate Championship. He also represented Maharashtra team in 30th Junior National, held at Calicut and runners up in the 30th Junior Nationals.
