It gives me immense pleasure to present before you the report of Gymkhana activities for the year 2006 - 2007.

This year as usual had been a fruitful year in terms of achievements of our students both from Degree & Junior college in various sports events in individual and team event at intercollegiate, interschool as well as State & National level.

Achievements of Degree College Students for various events are as follows:

• ATHLETICS - (WOMEN)

Prachita Patankar of S.Y.B.Com won the Gold Medal in long jump and Silver Medal in triple jump at the inter-collegiate competition. She represented Mumbai University at Ashwamedh and won Bronze Medal at Jalgaon in December 2006. She also won Bronze medal in long jump at open junior National Athletic meet held at Allahabad in October 2006.

• ATHLETICS - (MEN)

Prathamesh Rane won the Gold Medal in Shot-put and Bronze Medal in discus throw at the inter-collegiate Athletic competition. He also represented Mumbai University at Ashwamedh and won Silver Medal in Shot-put.

• BADMINTON

Our College badminton team comprising of Pavan Singh and Sadashiv Rajguru is the quarter finalists of the inter-collegiate tournament held at Mumbai. Pawan Singh is runner-up in individual Men's singles of Mumbai University Championship. He is also winner in the West Zone Inter University Championship and represented University of Mumbai at All India University championship where the Mumbai University finished at third place.

Rohit More :- He is the winner of Men's Doubles event in the Maharashtra Senior State Selection Championships at P.J.Hindu Gymkhana and at Mandapeshwar, Borivli.

- **CRICKET**

Our College Cricket team is the winner of Zone III and qualified for Mumbai University Inter Zonal Tournament.

- **KABADDI** (WOMEN)

Advaita Mangle of T.Y.B.Com is the Captain of Mumbai University, team of Ashwamedh, and she also represented Mumbai University at all India Inter University Tournament, where Mumbai University Won Silver Medal. She also represented Maharashtra at Open National Tournament. This year she had been selected as the “Best Sports-person”.

- **KABADDI** (MEN)

Our College men’s Kabaddi team is the semi-finalist for Zone III. Swapnil Ghadi TYBA represented Mumbai University at Ashwamedh. and all India University Tournament and won Gold Medal at Ashwamedh..

- **SWIMMING**

Tejashree Ganpatye of F.Y.B.Com participated in the Inter-University National Swimming Competition at Chandigarh. She got Silver Medal in 200 meter Breast Stroke. She won a Bronze medal in 4X100 Free Relay and also a Bronze medal in 4X200 Free Style Relay.

She also participated in Senior National at Bangalore where for 50 meter Breast Stroke she ranked 8th and 200 meter Breast Stroke she ranked 6th.

- **WRESTLING**

Nilesh Shinde of TYBA won Bronze Medal in 96 kg weight group at Inter-Collegiate Wrestling Competition held at Poladhpur.

- **WEIGHT LIFTING**

Shankar Thevar of F.Y.B.Com stood 1st in University of Mumbai weight-lifting competition at Shahapur. He placed 3rd in weightlifting of Brihan Mumbai Mayor’s Cup 2006-07. He won the 1st Place in Body building of Thane Kishore District Competition and is qualified to the State level.

- **POWER LIFTING**

Shankar Thevar of F.Y.B.Com stood 1st in University of Mumbai power-lifting competition at Malad. (Group 82 K.G)

Vijay Dudhade (TYBA) ranked first in University of Mumbai in Power-Lifting held on 15th October 2006 at Malad. (Group 56 K.G)

- **BOXING**

Elvis Henry T.Y.B.Com won the Bronze medal in Superheavy Kg group in boxing at Inter-Collegiate Tournament held at Thakur College, Kandivili, Mumbai in November 2006.

- **JUDO**

Sanchita Gaikar FYBA won the Bronze Medal at Inter-Collegiate competition in Judo.

- **KARATE**

Shriprasad Gore FYBMS won silver medal at 3rd Asia Championship 2006, he won Gold Medal at 3rd open state Karate Championship and won Bronze Medal in weapon event. Also he got Gold Medal in WFSCO, 2nd Thane District championship. He passed referee examination (state level) organized by school games federation of India.

- **BEST PHYSIQUE**

The Best Physique Competition was held on 18th Dec. 2006, Shankar Thevar secured 1st place and Vijay Dhudhade secured 2nd place from students of degree college. Darshan Sakpal from Junior College was selected for Consolation Prize.

Achievements of Junior College student for various events are as follows –

- **BADMINTON** (BOYS)

Our Star badminton player Akshay Dewalkar,SYJC won Gold Medal at South Asian Games held in August 2006 in Colombo in the team championship. Akshay represented India in official senior Indian team and also won the Bronze Medal in the individual Men's Doubles event. Akshay also represented India in the Junior Asian Championship held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia in the World Junior Championship in Incheon, Korea.

Akshay was the first Indian to enter the quarterfinals of the World Championships.

Akshay won the Junior National Championship in the double event in 2nd year of succession.

Akshay is selected by the Government of India list of 2010 Commonwealth Games in New Delhi.

Zaman Kazi S.Y.J.C Com represented Maharashtra for School Nationals in Badminton Tournaments in Kerala in the month of January 2007.

Pritesh Visave F.Y.J.C Com has participated in the sub-junior National Badminton Championship held at Pondicherry in October 2006.

- **BADMINTON** (GIRLS)

Winners of Thane District Inter-School Badminton Tournament finished in Runners-up in Mumbai Zonal Tournament.

Ankita Malgaokar & Varada Dixit have been selected to represent Maharashtra at School Nationals to be held in Kerala in the Month of January 2007.

- **ATHLETICS** (BOYS)

Mosin Shekh of 12th Commerce won the Silver Medal in 400 meters run at Thane District Inter Junior Collegiate Athletic meet and 4th place in Mumbai Zonal Competition and participated in state level competition and he is selected for National Relay.

As well he secured IVth place at Youth National in October 2006 at Andhra Pradesh.

Represented Mumbai Division in 50 meter & 100 meter Free Style at State level & won Bronze Medal in the Competition held at Nagpur.

Minal Jadhav Of F.Y.J.C |Com represented Thane District in Kabaddi at State level open competition & won the Bronze medal.
